Make the Loop Game Cards were created to practice addition and reinforce basic facts and can be used when you have just a few minutes to spare.

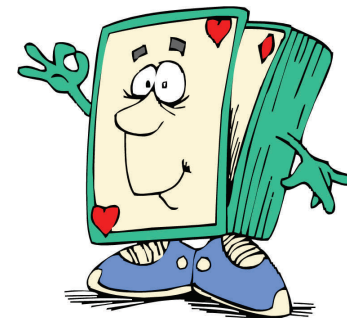
The focus of this particular set is addition skills, including simple facts.

HOW TO PLAY

Give each student a set of cards and give them a few minutes to look at them.
Some students may need a teacher to help them join in if necessary in order to disperse all cards.
One student begins by holding a card.
The student who has the answer to the previous card goes next.
Play continues until you get back to the student who began.

If time permits, you can have the students trade cards and play again.

**Two blank cards have been included and be used as replacement cards if needed.
