Diagraph – ch, tch  
Inflection – es  
HFW – air, fly, friends, grew, need, play, rain, watch

## Lesson 16 – One More Friend

r-controlled vowels – er, ir, ur  
Inflections – er, est  
HFW – always, by, Cow’s, join, nice, please, room

## Lesson 19 – Little Rabbit’s Tale

long vowel (e) – e, ee, ea  
Long vowel (o) – ow, oa  
Contractions – ‘ve, ‘re HFW – dear, door, hurry, mother, should, sky, told

## Lesson 22 – We’re Going on a Picnic!

Long vowel (i) – i-e  
Inflections – ed, ing  
HFW – because, light, right, those, walked

## Lesson 25 – Amazing Animals

Long vowel (u) – oo/u-e  
Inflections – ed, ing  
HFW – clear, color, good-bye, hair, kinds, only, toes

## Lesson 28 – At the Crayon Factory

long vowel (e) – y, ie  
Inflections – ed, er, est, es  
HFW – able, almost, blue, great, poured, took, traveled

## Lesson 2 – The Van

Short vowel (a)  
Phonograms – at, ag, and  
HFW – in, no, too

## Lesson 5 – Dot and Bob

Short vowel (o)  
Inflections – ed, ing  
HFW – find, much, thank

## Lesson 8 – Beth’s Job

Diagraph - th Short vowel (e)  
Initial blends with “s”  
HFW – don’t her, line, Mr., new, says , water

## Lesson 11 – Land of Ice

r-controlled vowel – or, ore  
Compound words  
HFW – animals, cold, fish, from, their, under, very

## Lesson 14 – Mark’s Big Day

r-controlled vowel – ar  
Inflections – ed, ing  
HFW – again, feel, house, know, loud, Mrs., put, say

## Lesson 17 – Can Elephants Paint?

Syllable – le Inflections – ed, ing  
HFW – buy, carry, money, other, paint, paper, would

## Lesson 20 – Ways People Live

Long vowel (a) – ai, ay  
Phonograms – ay, ain, ail, aid  
HFW – cool, dry, four, holes, move, place, warm

## Lesson 23 – On Saturday

Long vowel (o) – o-e  
Phonograms – ose, oke, one, ole  
HFW – brown, city, hello, loudly, love, pulled

## Lesson 26 – Blast Off!

Long vowel (i) – y, ie, ig  
Contractions – ‘d, ‘ve, ‘re  
HFW – climbed, Earth, fooling, thought, table

## Lesson 29 – Sand Castle

Vowel diphthong – oo, ew  
Phonograms – ool, ew  
Contractions – ‘d, ‘ve, re HFW – boy, building, tomorrow, toward, welcoming

## Lesson 3 – Big Rigs

Short vowel (i)  
Contraction – ‘s  
HFW – get, hold, home, so, soon

## Lesson 6 – All on the Map

Variant Vowel (a) - all  
Contraction – n’t  
HFW – how, make, of, some

## Lesson 9 – Plants Can’t Jump

Short vowel (u)  
Short vowel (e)  
Initial blends with “r”  
HFW – be, does, food, grow, live, many

## Lesson 12 King Midas and His Gold

Digraph – sh, th  
Initial blends with “l, s, r”  
HFW – came, could, gold, happy, made, night, saw, were

## Lesson 15 – Tomas Rivera

Digraphs – qu, wh  
Inflections – ed, ing  
HFW – about, books, family, name, people, read, work, writing

## Lesson 18 – Snow Surprise

Long vowel (o) – ow, oa  
Phonograms – ow, oat, own, oast  
HFW – mouse, our, over, pretty, surprise, three

## Lesson 21 – Flake, the Missing Hamster

Long vowel (a) - a-e  
Phonograms – ake, ate, one, ode  
HFW – around, found, gone, hears, might, near, open, tired

## Lesson 24 – Mystery of the Night Song

Consonants – c, g, dge  
Long vowels (a)/(i)– a-e/i-e Contractions – ‘s, n’t, ‘ll HFW-busy, become, eyes, high, listen, talk, visitor, remembered

## Lesson 27 – Ebb and Flo and the Baby Seal

Vowel diphthong – ow, ou, Phonograms – out, ow, own, ound  
HFW – answered, baby, done, heard, pools, pushed, together

## Lesson 30 – Frog and Toad Together

long vowels (i)(o)  
Phonograms – ind, ild, old,  
HFW – any, front, nothing, ready, sorry
